



The agent dispatches the local services necessary for a successful port call by arranging pilotage, towage, and customs entry and clearance, while navigating deftly through the myriad national and local regulatory requirements involving the ship, her cargo and crew.





Life at IMBA


IMBA's student body is extremely diverse, motivated and typical, making IMBA the vibrant place that it is.

The postgraduate students at IMBA are exposed to a variety of co-curricular and skill-building opportunities.

The Career Services Division, apart from organising placements in leading multinationals – both in India and overseas, trains students in key careerelated skills through the year. Workshops for MS Excel, mock interviews, group discussions, soft skills training and CV writing are conducted by experienced trainers to prepare students for recruitment and selection processes.

Postgraduate students also participate heavily in industry conferences held at IMBA, which host lectures by eminent persons and provide a forum to network with key professionals from reputed rms. This is complemented by frequent guest lectures by eminent speakers from all walks of life.

The thriving E-Cell provides a great platform for budding entrepreneurs to exchange and explore ideas. Postgraduate members of the cell have also participated in and secured prizes at business plan competitions organised by industry bodies. Visits to marquee organisations like the Ports and commercial shipping rms also mark the Graduate Diploma students' annual calendar as do events such as inter-college festival and various other intra-college sports, dance, music, media and social work events.



Admission Process

IMBA follows a rounds-based rolling admissions policy. This means that the applicants who apply in an earlier round have a higher likelihood of being accepted into the programme of their choice. It also means that the applications will be closed as soon as all seats are lled. The admission process comprises of two steps:

STEP 1 : Filling the Application Form

To apply kindly meet the academic counsellorand II up the admission form and submit it along with the registration fee.

All necessary documents as listed on the application form, must be submitted at the time of applying. Candidates who have successfully completed or are in the nal semester of full time undergraduate degree programme, are eligible to apply for the Graduate Diploma programmes at IMBA.

STEP 2 : Personal Interview (PI).

There is no exemption from the PI on any grounds.

The personal interview is intended to assess the applicants intention to pursue higher studies at our academy their ability to perform successfully and match our required standards.

Outstation & International students may appear for PI through online mode via Skype, or through the of ine mode at the IMBA academy in Dehradun.

Once all two steps are completed, a candidate's application will be reviewed by the Admissions Committee in full. The nal admission decision will take into consideration:

Performance in the PI (60% weight)

Graduation (50% Weight)

If you are made an offer of admission but do not have your graduation/ Class 12th scores by then, you may con rm your place, but this will stand void if the graduation/ Class 12th scores are not submitted before the commencement of the programme.

Note- All decisions made by the IMBA Admissions Committee are nal and binding.


