



Module 1

Ship Brokering

This module provides an overview of the role of a shipbroker, the process of negotiations and post-fixture operations. Further to that this module will assist students to get familiarized with dry market conditions and assessment of various dry bulk routes.

Module 2

ShipChartering

This module covers the chartering aspect of the ship business whereby the students will get familiarized with the hiring of the vessel as well as fixing of the cargo. This shall includ charter-party, basics of sea economics, knowledge of hire as well as freight calculation and assessment of the lay time.

Module 3

Port



Agency Operations

This module covers an introduction to port agency operations and provides an in-depth look at topics such as port practices, port operations, cargo handled by Indian and foreign ports, Custom house practices. Further to that, students will learn the jobs and responsibilities of a port agent and Calculation of port related costs.

Module 4

Ship andCrew Management

This module will look at the administration and operation of ships. It will also cover the function of the operations department within a shipping company, the crew management and the main divisions within Human Resource Management (HRM). You will also get an introduction to the techniques of HRM practice, whilst also looking at the employee involvement and the employee satisfaction, motivation and attitudes to work survey.

Module 5

Ship Operations



This module includes the understanding of the basics of the ship design, maritime terminology, various types of contracts and the liability of the ship owners. The students will get a thorough understanding of voyage related expenses and will learn the concepts of voyage estimation to calculate the profitability of the voyage.re operations. Further to that this module will assist students to get familiarized with dry market conditions and assessment of various dry bulk routes.

Module 7

Port Management

This module will look at the full spectrum of port management and look at topics such as port and terminal management, port economics, Indian port development, port planning and other such topics. Apart from classroom training, students might also have to do project work, dissertations, participate in industry visits, or gain practical know-how through internships.

Module 6

International Logistics & Maritime Law

This module will look at the full spectrum of maritime logistics and look at topics such as trade-offs and logistics, distribution channels, modal choice & intermodal systems and port management. It will go on to cover benchmarking in logistics, reverse logistics and green logistics. Further to that, students will be given an overview on International maritime law which includes Commercial and trade law. This will be supported by arbitration practice.

Life at IMBA


IMBA's student body is extremely diverse, motivated and typical, making IMBA the vibrant place that it is.

The undergraduate and postgraduate students at IMBA are exposed to a variety of co-curricular and skill-building opportunities.

The Career Services Division, apart from organising placements in leading multinationals – both in India and overseas, trains students in key career-related skills through the year. Workshops for MS Excel, mock interviews, group discussions, soft skills training and CV-writing are conducted by experienced trainers to prepare students for recruitment and selection processes.

Postgraduate students also participate heavily in industry conferences held at IMBA, which host lectures by eminent persons and provide a forum to network with key professionals from reputed firms. This is complemented by frequent guest lectures by eminent speakers from all walks of life.

The thriving E-Cell provides a great platform for budding entrepreneurs to exchange and explore ideas. Postgraduate members of the cell have also participated in and secured prizes at business plan competitions organised by industry bodies. Visits to marquee organisations like the Ports and commercial shipping firms also mark the Graduate Diploma students' annual calendar, as do events such as inter-college festival and various other intra-college sports, dance, music, media and social work events.



Admission Process

IMBA follows a rounds-based rolling admissions policy. This means that the applicants who apply in an earlier round have a higher likelihood of being accepted into the programme of their choice. It also means that the applications will be closed as soon as all seats are filled. The admission process comprises of two steps:

STEP 1 : Filling the Application Form

To apply kindly meet the academic counsellorand fill up the admission form and submit it along with the registration fee.

All necessary documents as listed on the application form, must be submitted at the time of applying.

Candidates who have successfully completed or are in the final semester of full time undergraduate degree programme, are eligible to apply for the Graduate Diploma programmes at IMBA.

STEP 2: Personal Interview (PI).

There is no exemption from the PI on any grounds.

The personal interview is intended to assess the applicants intention to pursue higher studies at our academy, their ability to perform successfully and match our required standards.

Outstation & International students may appear for PI through online mode via Skype, or through the offline mode at the IMBA academy in Dehradun.

Once all two steps are completed, a candidate's application will be reviewed by the Admissions Committee in full. The final admission decision will take into consideration:

Performance in the PI (60% weight)

Graduation Scores (50% weight)

If you are made an offer of admission but do not have your graduation/ Class 12th scores by then, you may confirm your place, but this will stand void if the graduation/ Class 12th scores are not submitted before the commencement of the programme.

Note- All decisions made by the IMBA Admissions Committee are final and binding.
